



Announcement of King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi on Compensation of Advisors for the Seminar Course

In accordance with the program requirements of the Joint Graduate School of Energy and Environment for advisors to supervise the work of students enrolled in the Seminar Course, some financial compensation should be paid to the advisors.

By virtue of Article No. 10 (8) of the Regulation of King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi on "Establishment and Operation of the Joint Graduate School of Energy and Environment B.E.2541 (1998)", and in accordance with Resolution No. 4/2542 (1999) of the Meeting of the Board of Trustee dated September 9, B.E. 2542 (1999), the following Announcement was issued.

Clause 1: In this Announcement "Advisor" means the person who provides advice, and encourages and supports a student in preparing a presentation as well as in correcting the review paper to be developed during the Seminar Course.

Clause 2: The compensation rate for an advisor who is not an instructor of the Joint Graduate School of Energy and Environment is 1,500 Thai Baht per student. In case there is more than one advisor per student, the compensation must be equally divided among the advisors.

Clause 3: This Announcement shall come into force starting since semester 2/2542 (1999).

Clause 4: The director of the Joint Graduate School of Energy and Environment shall act in accordance with this Announcement.
