## Process of thesis defence examination for Master degree & Doctoral degree

- (1) Consult the Academic Calendar
- 2 Submit thesis report to all committees



- For Thai external examiner, student can submit thesis report to him/her directly
- For foreigner external examiner, student submit thesis report to the Academic section, the Academic staff will submit it to him/her
- 3 Submit AS14 request for Exam and AS15 Report submission via online system



4 Thesis Defence Examination date

Student must submit thesis report and AS14 form at least 14 days (for master degree) and at least 30 days (for doctoral degree) before examination date. Otherwise student will not allow to have the final defence examination, result of thesis grade will be "U"

The advisor is responsible for ensuring the correctness of the English language in the thesis before submitting it to the committee.





Students must submit the final version of their thesis within 60 days after passing the final defense examination.

Failure to do so will result in a thesis grade of "U." In such cases, the student must re-take the examination and register for the following semester.
