

Announcement of the Joint Graduate School of Energy and Environment on Scholarship Criteria B.E. 2542 (1999)

Based on Article No. 7 of the Announcement of King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi on "Scholarship Criteria of the Joint Graduate School of Energy and Environment (2nd Issue) B.E. 2542 (1999)", and in accordance with Resolution No. 4/2542 (1999) of the Meeting of the Board of Trustee dated September 9, 2542 B.E. (1999), the Joint Graduate School specified the following criteria for scholarships:

1. The type of scholarship to be awarded to students/applicants of the Joint Graduate School of Energy and Environment depends on their financial status. The types are as follows:

Type	Applicants entitled to consideration
1	Applicants who do not have a monthly income and do not receive a scholarship
	from any other sources. The scholarship shall be awarded until graduation.
2	Applicants who do not have a monthly income and do not receive a scholarship
	from any other sources, or applicants who have a monthly income but do not
	receive a scholarship from any other sources.
3	All applicants.
4	All applicants.

2. Students awarded with a 1st and 2nd category scholarship must have an excellent academic record; this includes:

For a Master's degree, the applicant must be awarded with an Honors Bachelor's degree

For a Doctor's degree, the applicant shall have an accumulated GPA of 3.75 or more, or a GPA of 3.5 or more and a published work.

3. Scholarships awarded to students may be reconsidered on an annual basis for those with unsatisfactory academic results. In this case, the category of the scholarship may be subject to change in each year.

- 4. The academic record/accumulated GPA used as piece of information to award a scholarship may follow different standards in different institutions. The Committee shall consider such information when awarding a scholarship.
- 5. The cost of living covered by the scholarship for Master's students and Doctoral students shall amount to 8,000 Thai Baht per month."
