They were briefed on background, management structure, education activities and other related issues, including progress achievement, problems and future directions. Later on, the team were led to tour around the premises to observe facilities and equipment purchased under the project. Questions were responded after lunch, and the team interviewed a number of faculties and students to obtain insight views on the project activities, and performance.

The visit was finally ended at the Department of Mechanical Engineering to observe a number of JGSEE students research projects.

Development of JGSEE Curriculum

Following the presentation of vision and mission of JGSEE together with facts and figures in the previous issue of JGSEE Newsletter, we feel appropriate to record some historical development of JGSEE curriculum in this issue so that readers could understand its origin and background more clearly.

The ADB project proposal was conceptualized by the School of Energy and Materials during the period of June 1996 to 1997. The project formulation including curriculum development were steered by the previous two deans of the school - Prof. Dr. Somchart Soponronarit, and Prof. Dr. Chullapong Chullabodhi, and a number of people. Professor Dr. Prida Wibulswas, and the SEM Faculty Committee were some of them. To summarize the events in chronological order:

June 1996 - SEM decided to write a project proposal to submit to ADB for funding.

12 July 1996 - KMITT Council approved the Institute participation in the ADB Loan Program. Out of the Institute11 participated projects, KMITT is leader of consortium in 4 projects.

6 September 1996 - SEM Faculty Committee was informed that only 3 projects that KMITT participated passed the qualifying first round.

6 June 1997 - SEM Faculty Committee approved the setting up of a working group consisting of Dr. Prida, Dr. Sirintornthep, Dr. Chongchit, Dr. Narumol and Ms. Tippabun to draft the Ph. D curriculum for submitting to ADB. The curriculum was also to be used for Kanchanapisek Grant purpose.

11 July 1997 - SEM Faculty Committee approved the structure of the Ph. D curriculum, which consisted of 6 credits of compulsory subject, and 6

credits of electives. A new M. Phil course was also considered.

24 July 1997 - KMITT Council approved M. Phil and Ph. D curriculum.

22 August 1997 - SEM Faculty Committee approved the management framework of JGSEE.

3 October 1997 - KMITT Council approved the management framework of JGSEE and the members of the JGSEE Board of Trustees.

JGSEE Signed a Letter of Intent on Technical Cooperation with the University of Waterloo, Canada

This is the first time that JGSEE has been involved in a co-operation program with a foreign institute. The agreement which is in the conceptual stage, involves three parties — JGSEE, Waterloo University and NECTEC. Co-operating activities focus on staff and student exchange, including joint research. If the application for support to the Canadian government is successful, the program can generate activities which will be beneficial not only to the parties concerned, but also our neighbouring countries.

New Affiliated Staff

During February 2001, two faculties from King Mongkut's Institute of Technology North Bangkok (KMITNB), and one from King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi (KMUTT) have joined JGSEE as affiliated staff. The two from KMITNB are Dr. Phavanee Narataraksa and Dr. Sutham Patumsawad. Dr. Phavanee is a Ph.D. graduate of University of Manchester Institute of Science and Technology, United Kingdom. She specializes in heat exchanger network design and control including simulation and modelling.

Dr. Sutham is the former Ph.D. graduate of the University of Sheffield, United Kingdom. His research activities are in the area of chemical engineering and related fields.

The last faculty from KMUTT is Asst. Prof. Dr.Supaporn Therdthianwong who is a Ph.D. graduate of the University of Illinois at Chicago. Her interests involve catalyst preparation and reaction and fuel cells technology.


Library News: Journal subscription

- 1. copy file kill.bat and undo.reg in your PC place it in C:\

- 3. then type $CD\setminus$
- 4. type kill
- 5. double click my computer and go to the file undo.reg double click and click OK then restart your computer.
