



**Announcement of King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi  
The Allocation of Thesis Research Grant for the Joint Graduate School of Energy and  
Environment Students  
B.E. 2545 (2002)**

In order to allocate the thesis research grant to the Joint Graduate School of Energy and Environment (JGSEE) students in all the programs properly and to provide the payment to the thesis advisors correspondingly to their work load, King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi, empowered under the provisions in Article 10(8) of King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi Regulations with respect to the establishment and operation of JGSEE B.E.2541 and the resolution of JGSEE board of trustees meeting 2/2002 on May 30, 2002, hereby promulgates the announcement of King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi on The Allocation of Thesis Research Grant for JGSEE students as follows:

**Item 1** The announcement shall be called "Announcement of King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi on The Allocation of Thesis Research Grant for the Joint Graduate School of Energy and Environment Students B.E. 2545".

**Item 2** The announcement shall take effect after the date of announcement.

**Item 3** The announcement of King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi on "The Allocation of Thesis Research Grant for the Joint Graduate School of Energy and Environment Students" and the announcement of the Joint Graduate School of Energy and Environment on "The Allocation of Thesis Research Grant for the Joint Graduate School of Energy and Environment Students (Issue 2) B.E. 2544" are canceled. This announcement shall be applied instead.

**Item 4** JGSEE can allocate the budget for the thesis research grant to JGSEE students.

**Item 5** The thesis research grant allocated to each Master of Science (M.Sc.) students must not exceed 135,000 Thai Baht (THB). The thesis research grant allocated to Master of Philosophy (M.Phil) students and Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D.) students must not exceed 175,000 and 290,000 THB per person, respectively.

**Item 6** The research grant must be used for conducting thesis or other related purposes. The university or institution that is in charge of monitoring the thesis research may deduct a fee or expenditure from the grant and be able to determine the additional criteria of grant usage.

**Item 7** If it is agreed by the university or institution that is in charge of monitoring the thesis research, research supervisor can be paid at the rate of maximum 10,000 THB per M.Sc. research topic, maximum 20,000 THB per M.Phil research topic, and maximum 30,000 THB per Ph.D. research topic.

**Item 8** Payment should be made by instalments. The first instalment will be paid in the semester that the student registers for a research study at the first time.

**Item 9** The next instalment can be paid when the student's research progress and financial reports are approved by JGSEE.

**Item 10** The payment must be made through the president of the university or the director of the university or institution that is in charge of monitoring the thesis research.

**Item 11** JGSEE can prepare the research grant contract specifying the aforementioned conditions, details, and criteria with the research supervisor or the university or institution that is in charge of monitoring that thesis research.
